Almost everyone is familiar with Museum Delivery of your new Corvette. It has been described here several times. Two options to enhance your Corvette purchase are also available through the Museum. They are the Buyer's Tour and the Corvette Photo Album. If you have ordered or were planning to order a C7, these are must do items.

Edie and I did both of these and will do them again if and when we order a new Corvette. Robert and Linda Shellberg and Rick and Virginia Herrick will be doing both the Buyer's Tour and Photo Album this month as part of their C7 purchase. Brief descriptions of these programs follow. More detailed information is on the National Corvette Museum website.

Corvette Buyer's Tour

You and one guest see and experience the assembly of <u>YOUR</u> Corvette with your very own personal guide.

The tour begins at body assembly with installation of seats, doors, trunk, windshield, etc., then to the marriage of body and chassis, followed by the first start, the end of line and testing. Every effort is made for you to be able to be the first person to start your car. I did that and it was really exciting. It is the only opportunity to see the odometer at "0".

Depending on your car's schedule the tour usually takes parts of two days. If you are very lucky and your build starts very early in the day, it will be finished that afternoon. If you are unlucky, like Edie and I were, the car could start on Friday and be completed on Monday.

It is advisable to schedule your tour as soon as your car receives an order number. The total cost of the Buyer's Tour is \$800.00 and worth every penny to a Corvette enthusiast.

Corvette Photo Album

Whether you are ordering to take delivery at the Museum, participating in the Buyer's Tour or simply ordering your new Corvette to be delivered at your dealer – the NCM can help preserve a monumental part of your Corvette's history with a 20 page photo album that captures the complete build of your new Vette.

The 15'x 12" album is created with the highest quality photo paper preserved in a padded leather cover with high quality stitching detail, and includes:

- 20 plus pages of photos and text capturing your Corvette's build process
- Letter of authentication
- Letter from GM Bowling Green Plant Manager and the National Corvette Museum Executive Director
- Back page autograph area for memorable moments/events.

The photo album must be ordered 10 days before the car is scheduled to be built. However, it is advisable to contact the Museum as soon as the car's order number is assigned.

This amazing album is well worth the \$700.00 cost. A package price is available if you opt for both the tour and album. It is \$1,300.00, saving you \$200.00.

If you would like to see an album, let me know and I will bring ours to a club meeting. As to the tour, I can only tell you we would do it again.



If you are not a member of the NCM, join! The \$100 family membership is only \$75. You can save that in a year if you purchase enough from the Museum store.

The LSCC autocross will be held on the third Saturday of each month beginning in March and ending in November.

25 Years of Corvette Fun - Bill and Linda Ullom



"Not you, Bill." LSCC member Linda Ullom got used to hearing that back when she and late husband Bill would raise their hands to volunteer for a Parade or Display. Their beloved '64 Roadster had a reputation for overheating at just the wrong time, and fellow Club Members weren't letting them forget it!

It was all in fun, of course, and the camaraderie would continue for another 2 ½ decades. **This**



month, Linda Ullom will become the 1st Club member to receive a 25 Year Pin.

Linda recalls that they found LSCC while looking for experienced Corvette owners to advise them on work that needed to be done to their '64. At that time, the Club was comprised mostly of older cars, and had a very active Shade Tree Mechanic group.

The Ulloms were active members from the start. Meetings were held at a Chevy dealership in Plano; then-President Tom Douglas hosted the annual Christmas Party at his home, and the Ulloms invited everyone over for a St. Patrick's Day party for many years. Bill was the organizer of the first Club group to participate in the Big Bend Open Road Race.

Two of the Ullom's good friends in the Club, Bill and Dottie Slocomb, had some fond memories:

"In the early days of the Big Bend Open Road Race, there would be a car show around the town square and a parade through the town after the car show was over. The people of Ft. Stockton turned out by the thousands. They loved it almost as much as all the participants of the race. Linda decided that since there were so many kids lining the streets that we should go to the local grocery store buy a lot of candy and throw it out to the kids. As we made our way along the parade route, Linda was busy throwing candy out to the kids and Bill was busy waving. He waved and waved and waved....so much that he looked like he was running for a local political office. From that point forward he became known as Mr. Mayor.

After Bill and Linda moved to Virginia they still participated in Corvette and Museum trips. Inevitably something would happen to their car. On one of the anniversary trips to the NCM the 6th gear ceased to function in their '99. Bill and Linda told the NCM that they were in possession of a very rare 5 speed C5 Corvette.

On the last Lone Star trip to the Black Hills, Bill washed the '99 so much that the back window fell out....or more correctly fell in. He then said that not only did he have a super rare C5 with a 5 speed but he also had the only C5 with a disappearing rear window. He took it to a local Chevy dealer and they used something similar to duct tape to get the window to stay put until Bill and Linda could get back to Virginia."

Linda served as LSCC Treasurer for 2 years, and was in charge of Lone Star Corvette Classic Registration for 2 years. She recalls that the first Classic was held in a parking lot at a hotel on I-75, and there was no shade! Her fondest memories are of buying their first new Corvette, a 1990 green convertible. Her favorite Club trip was the first trip to the Black Hills; they took 2 cars, the '90 and a 1996 Grand Sport convertible, because they took their 2 kids along.

Not even relocation to other States could dampen their enthusiasm for LSCC trips and activities; they remained members through moves to Atlanta and Tampa in the '90's and to Virginia in 2004.

Today, catching up with the ever-busy Ms. Ullom isn't easy. She now enjoys a silver C7, and paused briefly to chat about trips and family, as she headed



home from a 3,000 mile trip in her Vette. Linda honors her husband's memory by living the Corvette lifestyle to its fullest, and we are proud to have her as a fellow member and friend.






