

NCM News

The 2009 NCM Caravan is less than 2 months away, so it is the big news, but some related and non-related news deserve mention. First, the caravan...

NCM Caravan

We will be departing from Texas Motor Speedway on Monday, August 31, for the trip of a lifetime. If you're going, you will be so glad you did. If you are not, there is still time to change your mind.

Just consider, a caravan of thousands of Corvettes is just the beginning. Once in Bowling Green, grand opening of the awesome 47,000 addition to the Museum will kick off all sorts of activities, including a special ceremony unveiling the plaque commemorating Lone Star's contribution to the Museum addition. Bad News, Good News

Ernie (our old Aggie) and Betty Perkins had planned to caravan to the Museum with LSCC. Regretfully, they will not be able to. That is the bad news.

The good news is that Ernie and his car have been chosen to LEAD the caravans. His name was drawn to be one of four Corvettes to represent the Kentucky State Police and lead caravans from where they cross into Kentucky to the Museum. His car will be outfitted with state police signage and a working light bar. Sorrowfully, he will not get to keep the light bar. Gig 'em Ernie!

Hexagon Bricks

These new bricks are being installed INSIDE the new Museum addition. Installation locations cannot be specified. They are being placed adjacent to each other beginning at the north end of Corvette Boulevard. Installations of these bricks will pass under our LSCC plaque fairly soon, possibly by Labor Day.

We have one chance to beat the system. If you order a hexagon brick very soon from me, it will be made and then held until the installation of bricks reaches our plaque. In other words, order now and someday it will be placed under the

them the next day!).




